So my good people, instead of praying desperately or demandingly; instead of demanding God to answer our prayers the way we think they should be answered; instead of asking for deliverance, let us rather ask God that His Will, whether it be active or passive, be perfectly fulfilled in each one of us. If we but unite our will to His, completely and unreservedly, with no qualifications attached, - my good people - if we do just that, Heaven is assured us and we will have peace. We have the words of Our Blessed Lord on that.

May God bless each one of you in a special way, and may He help each one of us bear our cross now and in the future.

In the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost. Amen.
