LENT

"Remember man, that thou art dust, and unto dust thou shalt return."

"And have not Charity ..."

"Brethren, if I speak with the tongues of men and of Angels, and

have not Charity, I am become as sounding brass or a tinkling cymbal. And If I should have prophecy, and should know all mysteries and all knowledge: and if I should have all faith so that I could remove mountains, and have not Charity, I am nothing. And if I should deliver my body to be burned and have not Charity, it profiteth me nothing. Charity is patient, is kind: Charity envieth not, dealing not perversely, is not puffed up, is not ambitious, seeketh not her own, is not provoked

to anger, thinketh no evil, rejoiceth not in iniquity, but rejoiceth with the truth: beareth all things, believeth all things, hopeth all things, endureth all things. Charity never falleth away: whether prophecies shall be made void, or tongues shall cease, or knowledge shall be destroyed. For we know in part, and we prophesy in part. But when
