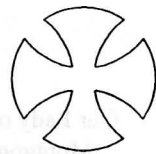
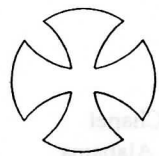


Friday, June 13, 2003, the Feast of the great St. Anthony

Nevertheless, if there is any sifting to be done, it is to be done by God, Himself alone. We are **NOT** the ones to do the sifting.
