As the matter stands, we believe or we do not believe! As the matter stands, we are people of Faith or we are not people of Faith! There is no middle way in this matter. We are the one, entirely - or we are the other, entirely. If we are people of no belief - of no faith - there is hardly anything that can be said to us that will be of lasting help. We have made our decision, and the matter rests there. If we are people of Faith - PLEASE GOD - if we are God's people of Scripture, we can and we should realize the seriousness of the situation; we should clearly understand the enormity of sin. If we are people of understanding, we should be able to focus our minds on the single sin of Adam and Eve, and direct our attention to the boundless consequences of that ONE - SINGLE - SOLITARY - SIN! Can anyone with any kind of mind at all fail to realize the seriousness of the problem? Unfortunately, Man defies reason! With mindless abandon, Man has fled from all the laws that constitute peace and order for humankind and for the universe. The abandonment of reason began its ascendance just seconds before the first bite was taken out of the apple! But no matter how fast he runs, he can never outrun his shadow! No matter how much he dreams, he can never outrun the reality of his fears!

Spiritual reality makes no sense to the man who sees reality only in that which he can pick up with his hands or see with his eyes. Spiritual reality is UNREALITY to such a one. Throughout the Biblical account God has been constant in giving warnings to thoughtless man. He even sent His only and most beloved Son to present man with "the way, the truth, and the life." - All to no avail. In more recent times - especially over the past 150 years - over and over again, by way of the glorious appearances of His most Blessed Mother, God has made serious reference to His mounting wrath, constantly demanding prayer and penance and mortification - acts of reparation to appease His wrath. He warns that He will send a punishment more terrible that the Flood. Again, all to no avail. The warnings fall on deaf ears as Man cheerfully continues his life of dreams in seeking safety and security in all the wrong places.
