

1. Tomorrow is the Feast of the great St. Michael the Archangel. It is also the feast day of our Father Michael. Please keep Fr. Michael in your very special prayers on this day.
2. Thursday, October 2, 2003, is the Feast of the Holy Guardian Angels, and is a patronal feast of the Benedictines of Christ the King Abbey and St. Joseph's Monastery.
3. This Thursday is also the first Thursday of October, with the usual Holy Hours and Benediction in the Abbey Church from 10:00 AM to 11:00 AM and from 3:30 PM to 4:30 PM.
4. Friday, October 3, 2003, is the Feast of St. Therese the Little Flower, and is a patronal feast of the Abbey Church.
5. This Friday is also the First Friday of October, with Masses at 6:00 AM and 8:00 AM.
6. Saturday, October 4, 2003, is the Feast of St. Francis of Assisi. It is also the feast day of our Father Francis. Please keep Father Francis in your very special prayers on this day.
7. This Saturday is also the First Saturday of October, with Masses at 6:00 AM and 8:00 AM.

If the weather does not permit us to go outdoors, we will remain inside the Church. The Rosary begins in the Church each evening of October at 7:10 PM.
