It is the day commemorating the coming of the Holy Spirit and the giving of enlightenment to the otherwise dense Apostles who were all huddled in a locked room for fear of the Jews. When the Light of God came upon them, the Apostles burst forth and fearlessly brought the Message of God to all the peoples of the earth, with all but one (St. John) suffering the glorious death of Martyrdom. Wisdom, Understanding, and Knowledge are but some of the Gifts imparted by the Holy Spirit. All are of

1. Next Sunday, May 30, 2004, is the Feast of the Holy Ghost - PENTECOST SUNDAY. For some, this Feast is given little, if any, attention. It is given little attention because it is not properly understood. To begin with,

- equal importance, but these three are especially important to us in these days of total religious collapse, mental chaos, and cultural disappearance. The Novena to the Holy Spirit began on last Friday. Saturday, May 29, 2004, is the VIGIL OF PENTECOST and is a day of fast and abstinence.
