and writing and publishing and arguing and debating, we have in reality accomplished nothing, and have succeeded only in making all the confusion worse confounded. Disagreement and quarrelling have fragmented every effort that would bring about healing and restore Christian order.

In all of this, most of us have failed to turn to God in prayer and penance and self-abnegation, and we refuse to work toward reconstruction of self. If we want God to come to our assistance, we must first admit our total dependency on Him and approach Him with humility of mind and heart, and with prayer — much prayer — more prayer, and yet more prayer. Only then will God move and come to our aid. With pure and unfeigned Christian Charity let us cry out to God for guidance, while at the same time let us pray for the repose of the soul of this man. God is the architect — not us!

Finally, as all the vicissitudes of these terrible days come crashing into our innermost beings, let this above all be at the center of our concerns: the honor and glory of God and the salvation of souls!

Our only duty is to pray for souls. We make no judgments concerning such matters. If there is any sifting to be done, it is to be done by God, Himself alone. We are NOT the ones to do the sifting.
