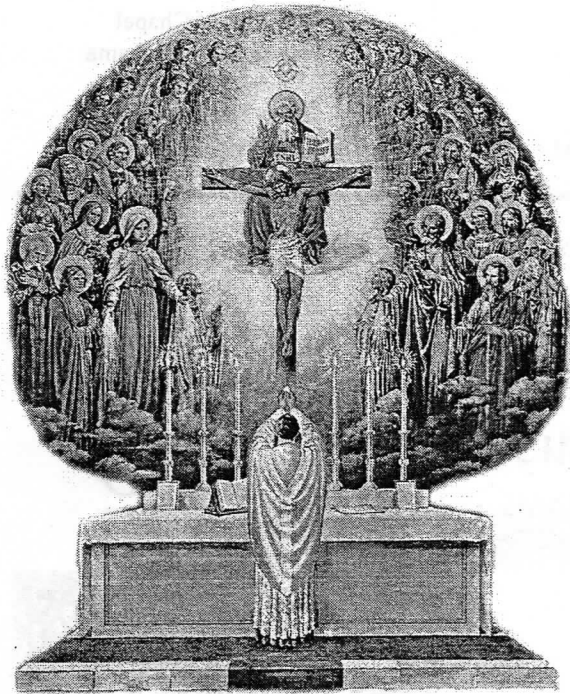


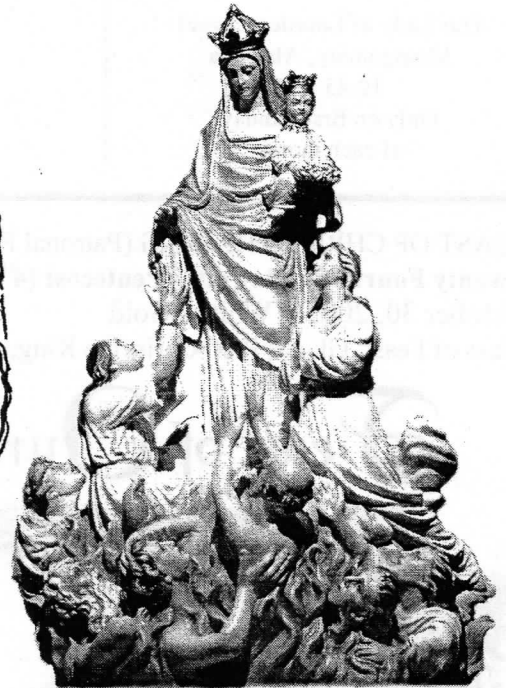
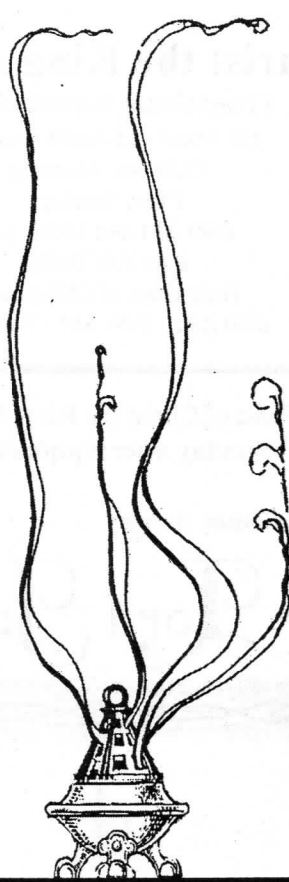

# All Souls Day

Wednesday, November 2, 2005



1. **Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament will immediately follow the 10:00 AM Mass this morning.**
2. There will be NO Catechism class today.
3. Today is the is the magnificent Feast of Christ the King, and is especially significant for us since it is the Patronal Feast of Christ the King Abbey. Let us all acknowledge the Kingship of Christ in our lives.
4. ***There will be Solemn Sunday Vespers and Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament at 5:00 PM today.***
5. Tuesday, November 1, 2005 is the Feast of All Saints, and is a **Holyday of Obligation**. **Masses in the Abbey Church will be at 6:00 AM, 8:00 AM, and 7:00 PM.** Those who are not able to attend Mass on that day should try to spend about one hour in special prayer in their Home Chapels.
6. Wednesday November 2, 2005, is the Commemoration of All Souls. It is NOT a Holyday of Obligation. **Masses in the Abbey Church will be at 6:00 AM and 8:00 AM ONLY.**
7. Thursday, November 3, 2005, is the first Thursday of November, with Holy Hours and Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament in the Abbey Church from 10:00 AM to 11:00 AM and from 3:30 PM to 4:30 PM.
8. Friday, November 4, 2005, is the First Friday of November, with Masses in the Abbey Church at 6:00 AM and 8:00 AM, and all-day Adoration of the Most Blessed Sacrament from 10:00 AM until 6:00 PM.
9. Saturday, November 5, 2005, is the First Saturday of November, with Masses in the Abbey Church at 6:00 AM and 8:00 AM. [Saturday is also the Feast of all the Holy Relics (in the Roman Calendar).]
10. Next Sunday, November 6, 2005 is the first Sunday of November. **Therefore there will be NO Mass at Saint Pius V Chapel in Birmingham next Sunday. There will also be NO Catechism class next Sunday.**
11. November is the Month of the Poor Souls in Purgatory. **do not forget the Toties Quoties indulgence** for the Poor Souls. Each and every time a visit to a Church or Chapel is made during the time between 12:00 Noon of All Saints Day and midnight of All Souls Day, reciting the usual 5 Our Fathers and 5 Hail Marys and 5 Glory Be's, with an added one of each for the intention of the Pontiff, one gains a plenary indulgence for the Poor Souls. Where it is impossible to enter a Church or Chapel, one's Home Chapel can with right and safe reason be used, leaving it up to God to decide whether or not the indulgence is thereby gained or not.
12. Please pray for all the Sick and Shut-ins of our Chapels. **LET US ALSO PRAY FOR EVERYONE.**
