The monastic community, if it has any truth in it at all, is obligated in one way or another to keep the light of TRUTH – the Light of FAITH from ever being blown out by the winds of evil. The monastic community, standing together with its Father in Christ, the Abbot, must remain an unflinching witness to the incomprehensible Sacrament of the EXISTENCE AND OMNIPOTENCE OF GOD!

Once again, whatever is here said about monks, is said with even greater emphasis about God's Angels on earth – the holy Nuns!
