## CHRISTMAS MASS SCHEDULE

Monday, December 25, 2006

Christmas Masses in the Abbey Church will be at Midnight on Christmas Eve (the Church will be open about 11: 15 PM), and at 10:00 AM on Christmas Day. There will be NO 6:00 AM Mass in the Abbey Church on Christmas Day.

Christmas Mass at St. Pius V Chapel in Birmingham will be at 9:00 AM on Christmas Day.

NB: Anyone receiving Holy Communion at the Christmas Eve Midnight Mass may <u>NOT</u> receive Holy Communion again at a later Mass on Christmas Day.

SPECIAL NOTE: There will be <u>NO</u> Confessions before the Midnight Mass or the 10:00 AM Mass on Christmas Day.

- 1. CATECHISM CLASS: Children 6 to 14 please meet Father Joseph in the vestibule right after the 10:00 Mass.
- 2. There WILL be 5:00 PM Sunday Vespers and Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament this afternoon.
- 3. Tuesday, December 12, 2006, is the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe (Roman calendar).
- 4. Early Notice: Wednesday, December 20, Friday, December 22, and Saturday, December 23, 2006, are the Winter Ember Days, and are days of Fast and Abstinence. Meat may be eaten ONCE (only) on Wednesday and Saturday at the main meal.
- 5. Early Notice: December 24, 2006, the Vigil of Christmas, this year falls on Sunday. Therefore, Christmas Eve this year is *NOT* a day of fast or abstinence.
- 6. Early Notice: Monday, January 1, 2007 (New Years Day), is the Feast of the Circumcision of Our Lord and is a Holyday of Obligation. Masses in the Abbey Church on January 1, 2007, will be ONLY at 6:00 AM and 10:00 AM. There will be NO Mass at Saint Pius V Chapel in Birmingham on January 1, 2007.
- 7. <u>N.B.</u>: In order to avoid any confusion, those who receive Holy Communion at the 10:00 AM Mass on Sunday, Christmas Eve, may also receive Holy Communion at the Christmas Midnight Mass.
- 8. Miss Caitlin Potter will carry the Baby Jesus and place Him in the Crib at the Midnight Mass this year.
- 9. Please pray for all the Sick and Shut-ins of our Chapels. LET US ALSO PRAY FOR EVERYONE. Let us pray for ALL the priests and religious men and women of the world. NO MAN, WOMAN, OR CHILD SHOULD BE LEFT OUT OF OUR PRAYER. God made all men to be with Him in heaven for all eternity, and this includes every human being on earth, regardless of station or condition or place. While Our Blessed Lord was hanging on the Cross He did not look around and pick and choose those for whom He was dying. He did not exclude a single member of the Human Race even His enemies from the wounded Love that came forth from Him during those momentous moments.
