NB: Anyone receiving Holy Communion at the Christmas Eve Midnight Mass may <u>NOT</u> receive Holy Communion again at a later Mass on Christmas Day.

SPECIAL NOTE: There will be NO Confessions before the Midnight Mass or the 10:00 AM Mass on Christmas Day.

Miss Caitlin Potter will carry the Baby Jesus and place Him in the Crib at the Midnight Mass this year.

- 1. CATECHISM CLASS: Children 6 to 14 please meet Father Joseph in the vestibule right after the 10:00 Mass. After today, there will be NO Catechism class until Sunday, January 7, 2007.

- 6. Thursday, December 21, 2006, is the Feast of Saint Thomas the Apostle.
- 7. Next Sunday (the Fourth Sunday of Advent), December 24, 2006, is the Vigil of Christmas, but is **NOT** a day of fast or abstinence. **DUE TO CHRISTMAS PREPARATIONS IN THE ABBEY CHURCH**, **THE USUAL 5:00 PM SUNDAY VESPERS AND BENEDICTION WILL NOT BE HELD NEXT SUNDAY**.
- 8. <u>N.B.</u>: In order to avoid any confusion, those who receive Holy Communion at the 10:00 AM Mass on Sunday, Christmas Eve, may also receive Holy Communion at the Christmas Midnight Mass.
- 9. Next Monday, December 25, 2006 (Christmas Day), there will be Vespers and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament at 5:00 PM.
- 10. Early Notice: Monday, January 1, 2007 (New Years Day), is the Feast of the Circumcision of Our Lord and is a Holyday of Obligation. Masses in the Abbey Church on January 1, 2007, will be ONLY at 6:00 AM and 10:00 AM. There will be NO Mass at Saint Pius V Chapel in Birmingham on January 1, 2007.
