- 8. Saturday is also the First Saturday of January, with Masses in the Abbey Church at 6:00 AM and 8:00 AM.
- Next Sunday, January 7, 2007, is the first Sunday of January. Therefore there will be <u>NO</u> Mass at Saint Pius V Chapel in Birmingham next Sunday.
- 10. <u>EARLY NOTICE</u>: Anyone wishing to have candles blessed on Candlemas Day (Friday, February 2, 2007), should bring them in nicely decorated containers, <u>WITH PROPER IDENTIFICATION</u>, and place them in the vestibule of the Abbey Church **no later than Sunday, January 28, 2007.**
