Today begins the holy season of Septuagesima

Septuagesima is a season all its own. It is a period of time set apart to prepare us all for the more important season of penance and prayer and sacrifice: Lent

Today we begin reading the readings assigned for each day during this season. These daily readings are important and should not be neglected without serious reason. The father of the family (or the mother, in the absence of the father) should do the reading, devoutly and with due gravity. The best time and place for these readings is at the table when and where everyone in the family is congregated for the main meal. Eating should not begin until after the completion of the reading and grace is said. Another practice full of importance is a few minutes discussion of the lesson found in the previous Sunday's Bulletin. This lesson should be explained to the children with loving care and Catholic concern. Early in life, by careful instruction and example, children should be taught the proper and reasonable and correct religious way of living the Catholic life. Every parent – indeed everyone – must stay constantly aware of the tremendous force of evil!
